



## ***Jonathan Rust Family Funeral Directors***

### ***Standardised Price List***

All funeral directors are legally required to publish a price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to allow you to compare prices between different funeral directors, as prices can vary.

**ATTENDED FUNERAL:** Includes the following – (Prices broken down to total £3,500) **£3, 500**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their cremation or burial.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements **£1,450**

Collecting and transporting the deceased from place of death (normally within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care. **£300**

Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. **£350**

Providing a suitable coffin – wood effect foil veneer	<b>£550</b>
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the client) – Does not include embalming	<b>£2</b>
The funeral to take place at a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the cemetery or crematorium (normally within 30 miles of the funeral director’s premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle, and includes four bearers.	<b>£848</b>

**UNATTENDED FUNERAL:** This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (Funeral Director charges only)	<b>£1,995</b>
Cremation (includes funeral director charges and cremation fee)	<b>£1,495</b>

**FEES YOU MUST PAY:** For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the burial fee on the local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for a local resident. **£310 - £725**

For a new grave, you will need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge other fees

For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee in the local area for residents. **£875 - £1,535**

Please discuss any specific religious, belief based and / or cultural requirements that you have with the funeral director

### **ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES:**

The funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them, Examples include:

Collection and delivery of ashes	<b>£1</b>
Embalming	<b>£120</b>
Funeral officiant (e.g. a celebrant / minister of religion etc – prices from	<b>£300</b>
Transfer of the deceased person into their home or place of worship.	<b>£300 - £400</b>

Other services supplied out of normal office hours – prices on request

The funeral director can give you a full list of all services provided. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services. You may wish to take care of some of these arrangements yourself without their involvement or use a different supplier.
