

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish a price list for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to allow you to compare prices between different funeral directors, as prices can vary.

ATTENDED FUNERAL: Includes the following (<i>Prices broken down to total £3,650</i>) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their cremation or burial.	£3,650
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements. A Funeral Director to arrange and conduct the funeral, managing donations and liaising with all third parties.	£1,500
Collecting and transporting the deceased from place of death (normally within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care, during office hours.	£325
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities, incl. washing and dressing.	£375
Providing a suitable coffin – wood effect foil veneer (York)	£575
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the client) – Does not include embalming	£2
The funeral is to take place at a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person directly to the cemetery or crematorium (normally within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle, and includes four bearers.	£863

UNATTENDED FUNERAL:

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (Funeral Director charges only)	£1,995
Cremation (includes funeral director charges and cremation fee)	£1,495

FEES YOU MUST PAY:

For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the burial fee on the local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for a local resident. For a new grave, you will need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge other fees.	£310 - £725
For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee in the local area for residents.	£875 - £1,535

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES:

The funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them, Examples include:

OUR TERMS OF BUSINESS:

Requirement of deposit prior to the funeral: You will always be advised by the funeral arranger of the amount required in advance by providing you with an estimate of costs for the funeral.

Once the confirmation of funeral arrangements which includes an estimation of costs has been signed, we respectfully request that a deposit is paid prior to the funeral taking place.

The deposit includes the following:

50% of the overall estimated cost of the funeral

Please consult the standardised price list, additional services price list for our products and services available.

If an unattended cremation / burial is chosen, full payment is required prior to the cremation or burial taking place.

Full payment is required within 14 days of the date of the final invoice.

The company may charge interest to you on the overdue amount at the rate of 2% a year above the base lending rate of the Bank of England or statutory interest, where applicable, which may change from time to time. The interest shall accrue daily from the due date until the date of the actual payment of the overdue amount whether before or after judgement.

Should matters escalate through to court action via third party debt collectors or solicitors, any court fees / recoverable cost, interest charges and enforcement costs, will be levied pursuant to relevant legalisation in addition to the outstanding balance. The prescribed court fees are set by the Ministry of Justice and can vary. Statutory interest will be claimed pursuant to statute or alternatively contractual interest applied.
